Important Points to Be Noted by Candidates

1. The UG NON-NEET Information Brochure is available in the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in. Candidates are advised to download the Information Brochure and read it carefully before filling the ONLINE application form. In the event of rejection of an incomplete application form, request for re-consideration will NOT be entertained.
2. This brochure is an information booklet alone. The guidelines contained are subject to modifications as per instructions received from time to time from the Government or Statutory bodies.
3. The entire counselling process from submitting application until admission will be made through ONLINE MODE ONLY.
4. A candidate can submit only ONE UG Non-NEET application. If a duplicate application is found, both the applications will be rejected and his / her candidature will be cancelled. Submission of application will be only through the CENTAC website – www.centacpuducherry.in. Candidates should check the website regularly for updates until the completion of the admission process.
5. An exclusive mobile number and an email id of either the candidate or the parent of the candidate is an absolute necessity. The access to the candidate's dashboard can only be made through OTP validation that is sent to the candidate's registered mobile number. Candidates are advised to use the same mobile number till all the admissions are over.
6. CENTAC will not be responsible for consequences due to non-follow up of NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES published in the website regarding counselling to NON-NEET courses for the academic year 2025-2026. Hence, candidates should regularly check the NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES that will be uploaded on the website for updates.
7. The documents that are required in digital format to be uploaded along with the application are given in Part I, Page No.25 of the UG NON-NEET Information Brochure.
8. For information on Reservation of Seats for various categories, refer Part I, Page No.16 of the UG NON-NEET Information Brochure. The details of category-wise reservation (No. of seats) can be viewed from the seat matrix that will be uploaded separately on the CENTAC website.
9. Application submission comprises entering of Personal Details, Academic Information, uploading of documents, payment of fees and submission of course preferences.
10. For information on course preferences refer Part I, Page 27 of the UG NON-NEET Information Brochure. Failure to enter Course Preferences (at least ONE), will result in non-allotment of a seat. Course preferences once submitted for a Round will be final.

11. Candidates are advised to choose as many course preferences as may be possible. This would facilitate in securing admission to an alternate course / college, in case the candidate is not able to secure admission of the higher preferred choice.

12. Till the last date permitted for submission of online application, the candidate will be able to edit the entries made by him / her including personal details and course preferences. After the last date, the application will be frozen with no further edit possible. For the last date of submission of Online application refer NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES published in the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in.

13. MERIT LISTS / ELIGIBLE LISTS and ALLOTMENT LISTS for each Round will be available on the website and the results WILL NOT BE COMMUNICATED INDIVIDUALLY.

14. All communication with the candidate will be only through SMS sent to the candidate's registered mobile number. Candidates should regularly check the NOTICE / PRESS RELEASES that will be uploaded on the website for updates.

15. It is mandatory for the allotted candidate to physically report to the college along with the original documents and pay the prescribed fees, so as to confirm the allotted seat. No other person in the place of the candidate will be allowed to submit the documents and take admission on behalf of the candidate.

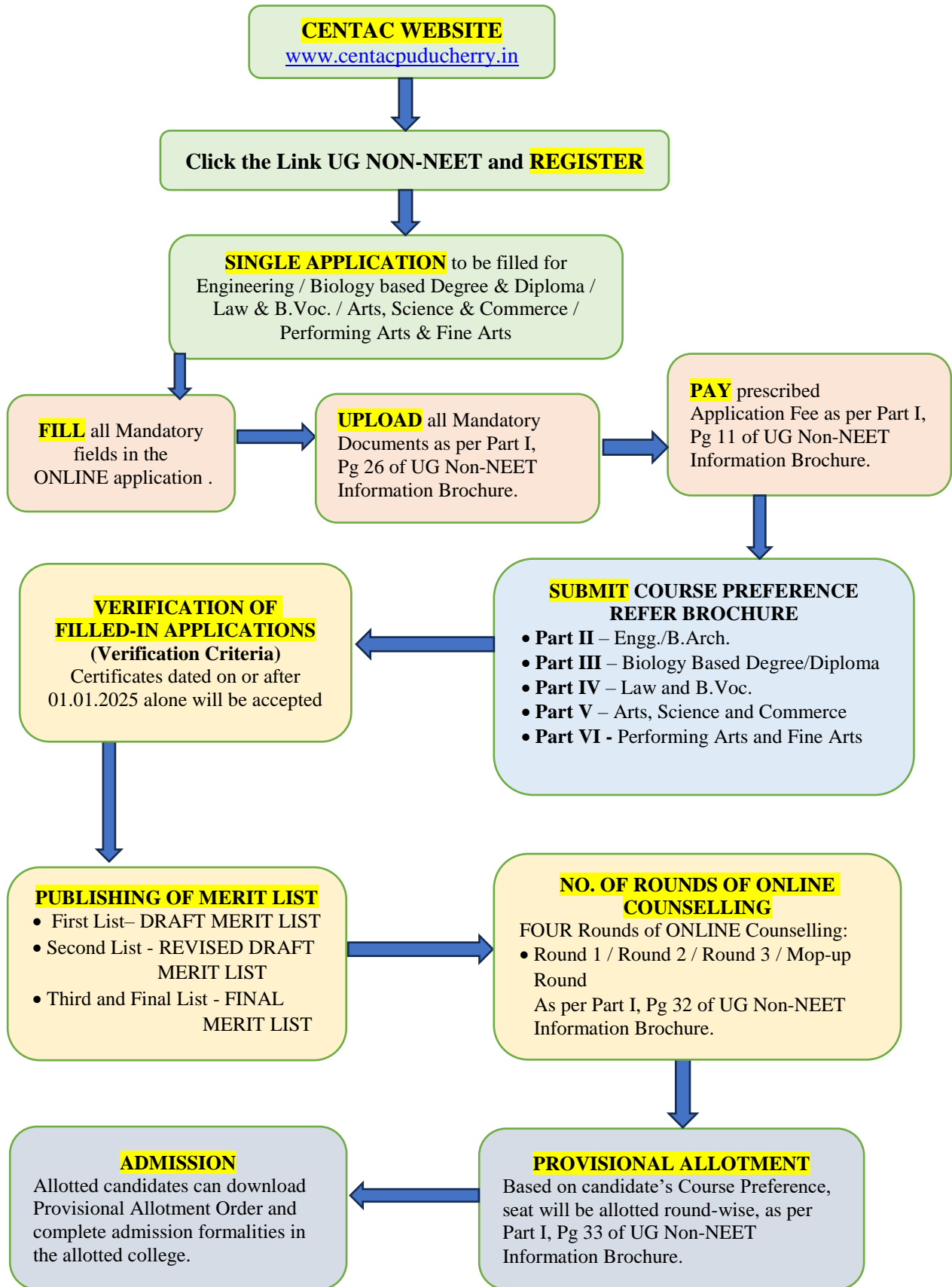

AN OVERVIEW OF THE UG NON-NEET ADMISSION PROCESS



SECTION – I: GENERAL INFORMATION

1. INTRODUCTION

The Government of Puducherry has centralised the admissions for all NEET-based Under Graduate (UG) Courses, Non-NEET-based UG Courses - Professional, Arts, Science & Commerce and Diploma Courses in Health Sciences offered in the Union Territory of Puducherry under one umbrella and has designated the Centralised Admission Committee (CENTAC) as the Counselling Agency. This centralisation of the admission procedure makes it easier for candidates to access information and services at one place.

The scope of counselling includes:

Candidate should ensure that all information entered during the online registration process is correct. Information provided by candidates like name of candidate, contact address, category, educational qualification, marks, date of birth, etc., will be treated as correct. The candidate will be able to make necessary updates even after publishing First List (Draft Merit List) and Second List (Revised Draft Merit List), but before publication of Third and Final Merit List.	The CENTAC will not entertain any request for change in the information after publication of the Final Merit List.

- a) Before filling the application, read the Information Brochure for the Academic Year 2025-2026 available on the CENTAC website, with the guidance of parent / guardian.
- b) Mere submission of application does not confer any automatic right to secure a seat. The allotment of a seat is subject to fulfilling the merit, admission criteria, eligibility, and such criteria as may be prescribed by the affiliating University, the AICTE and the State / Central Government.
- c) Candidates are advised to confirm the Tuition Fee structure from the UG Non-NEET Information Brochure / CENTAC website, and any other additional fee from the colleges, especially the Private Colleges before filling up the course preferences.
- d) **Refer the CENTAC website for the opening and closing date of ONLINE application.** CENTAC may reopen the ONLINE application, depending upon necessity.
- e) **FOR SUPPLEMENTARY CANDIDATES:** Candidates who have appeared for the **supplementary examination** should not wait for the results but should apply online on or before the last date. However, such candidates should upload the photo copy of the mark statement of the qualifying examination within the Last Date that will be announced by the CENTAC after the publication of Supplementary Results.

5. MODE OF COMMUNICATION

- a) The candidate will be informed of all the rounds of counselling of CENTAC through SMS and the same will also be published on the CENTAC website through NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES. After the online application is opened, the candidate should refer to the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in regularly.
- b) The candidate must ensure that the mobile numbers, e-mail address entered in the online application form are his / her own, as the CENTAC will send information / communication by SMS to the registered mobile numbers only. It is advised that the candidate also registers an alternate mobile number to which he / she has got access.
- c) No individual communication will be sent to any of the candidate apart from SMS. **CENTAC will not be held responsible for non-receipt of information due to wrong mobile number filled in the Online Application Form** or non-diligent follow up of NOTICES / PRESS RELEASES published on the CENTAC website or not checking the SMS sent to the candidate.

NOTE:

1. Unfilled JoSAA seats (self-supporting seats) will be filled through CENTAC as and when the seats are surrendered to CENTAC.
2. Candidates (NRI / OCI / Other State) willing to apply for B.V.Sc. & A.H. (Veterinary) course under the NRI / National – Self-Supporting quota should apply through the CENTAC NEET application.

8. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA OF CANDIDATES

8.1 NATIONALITY CRITERIA

A candidate seeking admission for Government Quota, Other State Quota, Management Quota and Self-supporting Quota through CENTAC should be an Indian National. However, French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the Treaty of Cession shall be treated on par with Indian Nationals, for the purpose of admission to all the courses.

8.1.1 RESIDENCE CRITERIA

a) RESIDENTS OF THE U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY

An applicant is considered to be a Puducherry Resident if he / she is an Indian National and satisfies at least ONE of the following criteria:

1. The candidate or whose parent (either Mother or Father or Both) or Guardian (in case of children

who have lost both parents) has been residing continuously in the U.T. of Puducherry for at least five years preceding the date of application.

(OR)

2. Those who have passed the SSLC / HSC or any other public examination and for that purpose had undergone academic studies continuously **for 5 successive classes immediately preceding the qualifying examination** (including the year of qualifying examination) in a recognized educational institution located in the U.T. of Puducherry and having their residence in the U.T. Puducherry for 5 years continuously during that period. **Mere stay in places such as residential hostel would not amount to residence.**

(OR)

3. Children of natives of the U.T. of Puducherry who have declared any place in the U.T. of Puducherry as their home town and so certified by their respective Heads of Office. Nativity Certificate in the prescribed format has to be enclosed. (G.O. Ms. No. 64 dated 25th May 2006).

(OR)

4. a) Children whose parents are Central / State Government Servants / Defence Personnel / Central Paramilitary Forces / Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially owned either by the Central Government or by the Puducherry Administration posted and serving in U.T. of Puducherry for at least a minimum continuous period of **three** years immediately prior to the last date of submission of application. (AND)

b) Children of the above said employees should have studied HSC of two years in any of the schools in the U.T. of Puducherry and should have passed the qualifying examinations (HSC) from the same school. (G.O. Ms. No. 04, Puducherry dated 09.02.2016 of the Chief Secretariat (Hr. & Tech. Edn.), Puducherry.

(OR)

5. Children of Defence Personnel who were killed or disabled in action and children of Central Government Servants / U.T. of Puducherry Government Servants / Defence Personnel / Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially run either by the Central Government or by the U.T. of Puducherry Administration who died while in service in the U.T. of Puducherry.

(OR)

6. French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the “Treaty of Cession” shall be treated on par with the candidates who produce the prescribed U.T. of Puducherry Residence Certificate. Such French Nationals will not be required to produce Residence Certificate; instead, they should produce a “Certificate of Registration” issued for this purpose by the French Consulate at Puducherry. Children of these French Nationals shall not be considered for admission under the Non-Resident quota.

b) OTHER STATES

"Other States" refers to students who are Indian Nationals and not Residents of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

8.1.2 NRI / NRI SPONSORED / CIWGC

The candidate must be a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) / ward of a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) / NRI Sponsored / CIWGC, as applicable.

a) NRI (Non-Resident Indian)

A candidate is a non-Resident Indian (NRI) if he / she is an Indian citizen holding an Indian passport, and who has been staying outside India for more than 182 days in the year immediately preceding the date of the application.

b) NRI Sponsored

A candidate's NRI Sponsor (Financial Supporter) should comply with the following conditions: He / She should be the nearest relation.

- Definition of the nearest relation (the following relatives having blood relations).
 - Real brother and sister of father i.e., real paternal uncle and real paternal aunt.
 - Real brother and sister of mother i.e., real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - Father and mother of father i.e., paternal grandfather and paternal grandmother.
 - Father and mother of mother i.e., maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.
 - First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.
- Such person should be an NRI.

c) CIWGC (Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries)

CIWGC means Children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries. CIWGC is a category under the DASA scheme, started by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, for the children of Indian expatriates (NRIs) in Gulf countries who want to study in top engineering colleges in India. Candidates under this category can apply only to courses available in the Puducherry Technological University (PTU), Pondicherry.

Countries under CIWGC are:

Bahrain, Iraq, Iran, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates.

8.2 OCI / OCI SPONSORED / FN

a) OCI (Overseas Citizen of India)

An Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder who holds a Foreign Passport will be considered as NRI only in the field of education. An Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) cardholder will not be considered under Foreign National category for educational purposes vide Ref.: OI-11011/01/2017-

OIA-II dated 19.05.2017 of the Director, OIA-II Division, Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India, Chankyapuri, New Delhi.

The OCI cardholders will now be eligible to the rights which were provided to them earlier to the notification dated 04.03.2021 of MHRD. They will be treated on par with Indian citizens and will be eligible for UR (General) category seats as well as NRI seats, provided their OCI card was granted before 04.03.2021. Those who obtained OCI cards after 04.03.2021 will be treated as NRIs and will be eligible for NRI seats only.

b) OCI Sponsored

A candidate's OCI Sponsor (Financial Supporter) should comply with the following conditions:

He / She should be the nearest relation

- Definition of the nearest relation (the following relatives having blood relations).
 - Real brother and sister of father i.e., real paternal uncle and real paternal aunt.
 - Real brother and sister of mother i.e., real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - Father and mother of father i.e., paternal grandfather and paternal grandmother.
 - Father and mother of mother i.e., maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.
 - First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.
- Such person should be an OCI.

c) FN (Foreign National)

Applicant must be a Foreign National possessing Foreign Passport and must not be of Indian origin. Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card holder even though he / she holds a Foreign Passport will not be considered as a Foreign National.

9.1.2 Regional Quota

a) This is a compartmentalized reservation on regional basis, applicable for admission to courses offered by Government Professional Colleges, for candidates who are residents of Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam regions and shall respectively be 18%, 4% and 3% of seats earmarked to the candidates of U.T. of Puducherry, vide G.O. Ms. No. 99 dated 10.08.2006 of the Chief Secretariat (Education).

b) The candidates claiming admission under specific Regional Allocation of seats for Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam shall satisfy the following conditions:

- Candidates should be ordinarily residents of the respective region for a continuous period of 5 years preceding the date of application.
- Candidates should have studied in the recognized schools located in the respective regions continuously for 3 years immediately preceding the qualifying examination (including the year of the qualifying examination)

c) This certificate should be obtained from the Head of the Institution in which they studied in the prescribed format (**Annexure-I.5**), and countersigned by the respective Chief Educational Officers of Karaikal and Mahe Regions, and the Regional Administrator of Yanam Region. They should also enclose a Residence Certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar of the respective regions, clearly indicating the address of residence.

d) The number of seats reserved for each region including the reservation applicable for each category in the respective region will be published in the seat matrix to be listed in the CENTAC website.

e) Regional Reservation is applicable only for Government Quota Seats in colleges offering Professional Courses in PTU, PKIET, WEC, AGLC, PAJANCOARI, RIVER, IGMCRI-CN, MTPG&RIHS and RGAMC.

9.1.3 Rural Quota

This is a compartmentalized horizontal reservation, applicable only to Arts and Science colleges for candidates from Rural Schools run by the Government of Puducherry. 1. Reservation under All India Category, Other State Quota and Self-supporting Scheme, will be subject to regulations / guidelines prescribed by the respective authority of the college / institution.

2. Residence / Regional / Special allocation once claimed in the application will not be changed under any circumstance.

3. All the claims for the Residence / Regional / Special allocation should be made in the proper format and should be signed by the specified competent authorities.

10. RESERVATION ALGORITHM

10.1 MODE OF RESERVATION

The Mode of Reservation while allotting the seats will be as follows:

- All the candidates should be Indian Nationals and Residents of Puducherry.
- Vertical Reservation on Regional basis will be made in the first instance (UR, EWS, OBC, MBC, EBC, BCM, SC, ST, BT) as per the Seat Matrix.
- Horizontal Reservation (FF/ ESM / PwD / MSP / Rural) will be done if adequate seats in horizontal reservation is not filled after fixing vertical and regional reservation, i.e., if the requisite seats are not filled while doing vertical reservation, the last candidates in the respective categories will be replaced as per merit.

An Example of the Method Used for Filling Horizontal Reservation:

If 5 seats need to be filled under the Persons with Disabilities (PwD) quota, and if 4 PwD candidates are already accommodated in the Vertical Reservation as per merit, then only 1 PwD candidate will be accommodated into the list by replacing the last candidate as per reservation. If the 5th PwD candidate belongs to the BCM category, then the last candidate in the BCM category will be replaced by this candidate.

10.2. De-RESERVATION OF SEATS

The seats will be de-reserved as per the Seats Conversion Algorithm in **Annexure-III**. In case any seat in any RESERVED category remains vacant, the same will be converted into UNRESERVED category and offered for counselling in the Mop up Round only.

10.3 CRITERIA FOR RESERVATION

10.3.1 U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY - VERTICAL RESERVATION

1. Unreserved (UR)

The seats under UNRESERVED (UR) are open to candidates irrespective of their caste or category status. Further, all SC / ST / BT / EBC / MBC / BCM / OBC candidates are also eligible for selection under the Open Merit category in addition to the reservations made to them.

2. Economically Weaker Section (EWS)

Economically Weaker Section is a subcategory of people belonging to the Economy-based Un-Reserved category having an annual family income less than Rs. 8 Lakhs and who do not belong to any category such as SC / ST / OBC across India. Candidates claiming admission under this category should enclose the recent EWS certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

Note: Not applicable for ALL courses. Refer Seat Matrix in CENTAC website.

3. Other Backward Classes (OBC), Most Backward Classes (MBC), Extreme Backward Classes (EBC), Backward Classes Muslims (BCM) and Backward Tribes (BT)

Candidates claiming admission under these categories should enclose OBC / MBC / EBC / BCM / BT certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

4. Scheduled Castes (SC)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Caste under **“The Constitution (Pondicherry) Scheduled Castes Order 1964”** dated 05.03.1964, read with “The Constitution (Scheduled Caste) orders (Second Amendment) Act 2002 (Central Act 61 of 2002) and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

5. Scheduled Tribes (ST)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as Scheduled Tribe under **“The Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Tribes Order, 2016”** dated 22.12.2016 and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

10.3.2 U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY - HORIZONTAL RESERVATION

1. Freedom Fighter (FF)

Candidates claiming admission under this category should be Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighters and they should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Officer-in-charge, Freedom Fighters Cell, Government of Puducherry.

2. Wards of Ex-servicemen (ESM)

Those who are registered as Ex-servicemen in the Department of Sainik Welfare (DSW), Government of Puducherry and have got an Ex-servicemen / Widow of Ex-servicemen identity card from the DSW should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Director, DSW, Puducherry.

3. Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

Candidates seeking admission under this category will be required to undergo a medical examination by a Medical Board constituted for the purpose by the Director of Health and Family Welfare Services, Puducherry, to ascertain and confirm the nature and extent of physical disability. The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialists out of which two should be of the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present him / her-self before the Medical Board.

The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from a Medical Board should not be more than THREE MONTHS old from the date of submitting his / her certificate for disabled candidates. In case, the certificate has been obtained earlier, the application will be rejected. The medical certificate

issued by the District Medical Board of the area concerned for this purpose is subject to confirmation by the Director of Health and Family Welfare Services. The decision of the Director of Health and Family Welfare Services, Puducherry, in this regard will be final. Refer **Annexure I.9** for the format of certificate to be submitted for PwD.

a) Eligibility under PwD for B.V.Sc. & A.H. Course

A candidate shall not be allowed for admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree course if he / she suffers disabilities in physical fitness (as mentioned in the Veterinary Council of India, Regulation 2016) as listed below:

- Disability of total body including disability of chest/spine more than 50%.
- Disability of lower limb of more than 50%.
- Disability of upper limb.
- Visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability.
- Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies, etc.
- Disabilities which otherwise would interfere in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.

b) Eligibility under PwD for B.Sc. (Nursing) Course

Persons with locomotor disorder of lower limbs between 40% and 50% only are eligible for nursing courses under the Persons with Disabilities Quota, as per the norms prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council.

c) Eligibility under PwD for B.P.T. / B.Pharm. / Other Biology-based Degree / Diploma Courses

For eligibility under the Persons with Disability Quota, locomotor disorder of lower limbs should be between 40% to 80%. For more details candidates are requested to refer to the Board of Governors in Supersession of Medical Council of India Amendment Notification No. MCI-34(41)/ 2018-Med./170045, dt. 04-02-2019.

NOTE: Candidates with any other DISABILITY other than the locomotor disability of the lower limb will not be considered for admission into B.P.T. / B.Sc. (Nursing) / B.M.L.S. / M.R.I.T. / M.I.T. D.T. / C.T. / P.A. / B.Pharm courses under this special category. Such applications will be summarily rejected without any intimation to the candidates.

d) Eligibility under PwD for Other Courses

For residents of the U.T. of Puducherry suffering from not less than 40% of any disability as certified by the competent Medical Authority.

4. Meritorious Sports Person Category (MSP)

a) The highest achievement of the candidates in only one annual tournament under the listed sports disciplines in a year will be considered for awarding marks. The List of Sports Disciplines Eligible for Sports Quota is given **Annexure II**.

b) Selection of candidates will be based on the marks obtained by the candidates following the guidelines given in the Government of Puducherry vide G.O. Ms.53 dated 24th May 2012 and G.O. Ms. No. 6 dated 14th March 2018 of the Chief Secretariat (Higher & Technical Education), Puducherry.

c) Participation / Achievements in sports / games, immediately preceding **five** years to the year for which admission is sought will be taken into account. National / State Level Championships/ Tournaments conducted by Organizations / Federations recognized by the Indian Olympic Association / Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, New Delhi, alone will be considered for award of marks (Recognition by the Indian Olympic Association / Ministry of Youth and Sports, New Delhi, should be relevant to the years concerned). Open / Invitational Tournaments of any kind will not be considered.

d) For Tennis Achievements of Top 3 players by his / her position in the ranking list published by AITA based on the ranking rules and the final rankings of the previous 4 years will be awarded marks for achievements and participation (Necessary forms from Associations are to be enclosed).

e) For Cricket, the Annual Official Championship / Tournaments conducted within the country under the auspices of the BCCI at the District / State National Level alone will be taken into consideration for that year.

f) The participation / achievements of candidates with nativity in the U.T. of Puducherry and who represented the U. T. of Puducherry alone are eligible for marks under the National Category. U.T. of Puducherry candidates are eligible to apply for admission under the Sports Quota and candidates of KVS / NVS / CBSE Schools within Puducherry are also eligible for marks.

g) All the achievement certificates are to be supported necessarily by the relevant participation certificates and appropriate forms /certificates. The relevant attested copies of the certificates issued by the appropriate authorities as detailed in the G.O Ms.53 dt.24.05.2012 are to be submitted along with the application.

h) No further enclosures of certificates will be entertained after the last date for submission of completed application.

i) A candidate can utilize the sports quota only once for these admissions.

j) A committee will be constituted to scrutinize the applications received under this category and will rank the candidates based on the marks assigned to the certificate enclosed along with the application, and the sports merit list will be published on the CENTAC website.

SECTION – III: FILLING UP OF APPLICATION

11. STEPS FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION

All the candidates seeking admission to the under graduate courses are required to apply ONLINE on the website www.centacpuducherry.in. Candidates are advised to read and familiarize themselves with all the foregoing information pertaining to UG Non-NEET counselling 2025-2026 before filling in the application.

Filling up of Application comprises the following:

1. Registration for First Time Users
2. Filling of Application (Personal Information → Academic Details → Attachments → Payment of Fees). Application should be completed and submitted before the specified last date.
3. Filling of Course Preference (Course Group → College → Course) should be completed and submitted before the specified last date.

a) Registration for First Time User:

- On the “New Registration” page, the candidate has to enter a valid Mobile Number and email ID. The candidate should take utmost care in providing the Mobile Number and email ID. Any change/modifications will not be allowed.
- Candidate shall then create a new password (of maximum six characters) for online registration purpose.

Important: An OTP (One Time Password) will be sent to the candidate's registered mobile number each time the candidate logs in to their dashboard.

b) Filling of Application:

- After successful registration, the applicant shall login using his / her “Registered email-id” and “Password” to fill the details in the online application form.
- Applicant can change the details in the application form and uploaded files using the “Back Button” before making payment.
- The candidate can then proceed with “Make Payment” and complete application submission.
- CENTAC disclaims any liability that may arise to a candidate due to incorrect information provided by him / her in his / her online Application Form.

13. PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEE

Payment of Application Fee is mandatory. Application Fee once paid is non-refundable. Applications without application fee will be deemed to be incomplete and will be summarily rejected. The candidate will be able to give his / her course preference only after payment of the Application Fee.

14. SUBMISSION OF COURSE PREFERENCES

a) While filling the ONLINE application, after payment of Application Fee, the candidate will be allowed to enter course preferences. The List of Colleges and Courses for admission is available in the respective parts of the Brochure.

- Part II – Engineering / B.Arch. Courses
- Part III – Biology Based Degree and Diploma Courses
- Part IV – Law and Vocational Courses
- Part V – Arts, Science and Commerce Courses

b) Steps for Filling Course Preferences:

First - Choose Course Groups. Select as many course groups as you want. The following Course Groups are available for selection:

- Arts, Science & Commerce
- Engineering (B.TECH.)
- Engineering (Food Technology)
- Veterinary (B.V.Sc & A.H.) **AND** Biology based Degree courses
- Biology based Degree courses in Health Science (B.Pharm)
- B.Sc. (Hons.)- Agriculture & Horticulture
- Law
- Biology based Diploma
- B.Voc.

Second - Select College available under each Course Group.

Third - Select Courses available under each College.

The candidate should arrange the courses according to his / her descending order of priority for allotment (Highest Priority should appear first).

Filling of Course Preference (Course Group → College → Course) should be completed and submitted before the specified last date.

c) Candidates are advised to give as many choices of courses for which he / she is eligible. If choices are not made, it will be deemed that he / she is not interested in those particular courses / colleges.

The candidate should give their prioritization of course preferences, as allotment will be done based on the order of the courses given by the candidate.

d) WITHOUT COURSE PREFERENCES, no course will be allotted to the candidate. It is therefore, the responsibility of the candidate to submit his / her course preference to remain in the counselling process. The candidate will not be permitted to edit his / her course preference after the last date for submission course preferences for each round. Once course preferences are given, they are final.

e) The allotment of seats will be made based on the course preferences submitted by the candidate and subject to the availability of seats, as per merit and reservation. Candidates are advised to refer to the seat matrix for details about the various courses, number of seats, reservations, etc.

f) Entry of Course Preferences for Subsequent Rounds of Counselling - Candidates willing to participate in subsequent rounds of counselling are required to enter new course preferences for each round. The course preference given in the previous round will be null and void.

15. VERIFICATION STATUS OF APPLICATIONS

15.1 Verification of Academic Claims

The academic credentials of the candidate will be verified for correctness of name, date of birth, HSC registration / roll number (as applicable), HSC marks entered by the candidate.

15.2 Verification of Residence / Community / Special Category Claims

a) All certificates submitted in support of Residence, Community and Special Category claims should be obtained ON or AFTER 1st January 2025 and those pertaining to Ward of Farmer/ Economically Weaker Section (EWS) should be obtained ON or AFTER 1st April 2025.

b) The certificates submitted by the candidates will be verified and verification status of the certificates will be updated in the candidate's dashboard with appropriate comments as to what the candidate has to submit / re-submit further to rectify the inadequacies in his application.

c) The Verification Status of such candidate whose certificates are found to be correct in all respects will be shown as "SUCCESS" in the candidate's dashboard. However, if any deficiency is found with regards to certificates furnished by a candidate, the Verification Status of such candidate will be shown as "FAILED" in the candidate's dashboard.

d) The candidate will be given adequate time to submit renewed certificates after publishing the Draft Merit List and Revised Draft Merit List so as to make up for deficiencies found if any with regards

to certificates submitted. If the candidate fails to submit renewed certificates even after publishing of the Revised Merit List, his / her Verification Status in the dashboard will continue to be shown as “FAILED”. However, the names of such candidates will be provisionally included in “FINAL MERIT LIST”.

15.3 Eligibility to Participate in Round 1 Counselling:

All candidates included in “Final Merit List” will be eligible for allotment in Round 1 as per the course preferences given by the candidate. However, all such candidates who have been provisionally included in the "Final Merit List" due to non -production of required certificates, will not be able to download Allotment Order from their respective dashboard. Such candidates will have to submit the renewed certificates through his / her dashboard, after which the candidate's Verification Status will be updated to "SUCCESS" and Provisional Allotment Order will be enabled and accessible to the candidate for download. If the candidate fails to submit the renewed certificates on or before the last date given for Round 1 admissions, his / her allotment in Round 1 will be cancelled.

15.4 Eligibility to Participate in Subsequent Rounds of counselling:

Candidates whose verification status is shown as “FAILED” can submit renewed certificates before each round of counselling. The Verification Status of such candidates will be updated to "SUCCESS" and will be eligible for allotment in the upcoming rounds of counselling. For those candidates who still fail to submit renewed certificates, the same process will be followed as elaborated under Clause 15.3.

16. MERIT LIST

a) The criteria for preparing the Merit List will vary course-wise. The Merit List will be prepared based on the marks obtained in the HSC or its equivalent qualifying examination or the marks scored in NEET, JEE, NATA examinations, whichever is applicable. In case of NEET / JEE / NATA, the cut-off marks fixed by the concerned authorities will be considered.

8. B.Tech. - Based on H.Sc. Marks
 - Other State B.Tech. merit list based on H.Sc. Marks will be operated after exhausting JEE based merit list
9. B.Tech. (Food Technology)
10. B.Vocational (B.Voc)
11. D.A.N.M.
12. Biology Based Diploma Courses

Candidates should refer to the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in for the merit lists of all the courses.

b) On verification of the candidate’s credentials, the First List which is the **Draft Merit List** will be published. This will be followed by a Second List which is the **Revised Draft Merit List** and then the Last and Final List which is the **Final Merit List**. Adequate time will be given to raise objections and submit documents, if any, between each publication of Merit Lists. Claim exercised with regard to Residence / Community / Special Category are subject to verification of the submitted documents.

- c) Candidates will be allowed to submit Renewed Certificates before each round of counselling i.e., Before Round 2, Round 3 and Mop-up Round.
- d) Fresh Eligible List will be drawn for each round based on the eligibility and course preferences submitted by the candidate.

17. NUMBER OF ROUNDS OF ONLINE COUNSELLING

There are FOUR Rounds of ONLINE counselling:

1. Round 1
2. Round 2
3. Round 3
4. Mop-up Round

Additional Mop-up Rounds may be conducted based on availability of seats.

a) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELLING

- The counselling schedule for each Round will be available in the CENTAC website www.centacpuducherry.in
- Allotment will be done through online (computer-based) counselling based on merit and rule of reservation.
- Each candidate will be allotted only one seat in each round.
- Sliding will be allowed from Round 2 onwards.
- **If a candidate opts for sliding and if a new seat is allotted, the earlier admitted / allotted seat will be automatically cancelled. Under no circumstances will he / she be permitted to retain the earlier admitted seat of the previous round.**
- **If a candidate fails to join the allotted / admitted seat (Fresh / Transfer) within the stipulated time, the seat will be automatically cancelled.**
- Mutual transfer / Individual request for transfer of college will NOT be permitted under any circumstances.

b) ROUND 1 / ROUND 2 / ROUND 3 / MOP-UP ROUND OF ONLINE COUNSELLING

- Sliding is allowed in Round 2 and Round 3.
- Submitting Fresh Course Preferences for Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 and Mop-up Round. Course Preferences given in the previous Rounds will be null & void.
- Submission of renewed certificates before each round of counselling i.e., Before Round 2, Round 3 and Mop-up Round.
- Publishing of Eligible List.
- Publishing Allotment List
- Downloading of Allotment Order
- Physical reporting to the allotted college for certificate verification and admission.

Options Available to Allotted / Not Allotted Candidates:

Case 1: Candidate is allotted a course. He / She joins the allotted course and college.

Case 2: Candidate is allotted a course. He / She does not join the allotted course and college.

Case 3: Candidate is not allotted any course.

- Case 1, Case 2 and Case 3 candidates can submit willingness for re-allotment in the successive Rounds.

18. PROVISIONAL ALLOTMENT

a) Once allotment is done, the Provisional Allotment list will be published on the CENTAC website. However, allotments of seats are provisional. The CENTAC reserves the right to withdraw any allotment made at any point of time which does not fulfill the eligibility criteria / regulations fixed by the competent authority from time to time. Eligibility / admissions / allotments made to and by the colleges shall be subject to the approval of the regulatory bodies like MCI / DCI / AICTE / Pondicherry University / Apex Bodies, etc.

b) The CENTAC and the Government of Puducherry reserve the right to make any verification as deemed essential at any point of time into the originality and authenticity of any of the certificates produced by any candidate to fulfill and stake his / her claim to any of the qualifying and eligibility criteria. If, on such verification, it is found that the candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates or has obtained certificates by suppressing facts, he / she will be liable for criminal prosecution, immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, forfeiture of fees paid and levy of penalty as prescribed by the competent authority and will be liable to be debarred from all exams / counselling in future; the authorities may also recommend blacklisting of the candidate to the AICTE/ Pondicherry University / Apex Bodies.

19. JOINING THE COLLEGE

a) Once the Provisional allotment is done, the candidate must download the **Provisional Allotment Order** and report to the allotted college within the specified time. If the candidate does not report within the given time, provisional allotment will be automatically cancelled. The similar procedure will be followed for ALL rounds of counselling.

b) The candidate is required to submit a printout of the Application Form, Provisional Allotment Letter and Original Certificates along with self-attested photocopies of all the required documents at the time of admission to the college with the prescribed fee for payment.

c) If CENTAC / College or other Authorities find that admission has been offered based on NOT fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements / false or incorrect information / documents and suppression of relevant fact, education qualification or quota, the allotment / admission offered will be summarily cancelled, irrespective of the stage of study of that course and the fees paid shall not be refunded in any case. Further, legal proceedings will also be initiated against the candidate, if required. Hence, candidates are warned against indulging in illegal practices, in their own interest.

d) The original documents (except Transfer Certificate) submitted by the candidates to the respective colleges shall be returned only after obtaining recognition from the respective affiliating bodies, and hence, **the candidates are advised to take enough numbers of photo copies of the documents before submitting the originals for verification.**

20. SAVING CLAUSE

a) CENTAC reserves the right to issue additional guidelines, or modify or delete the guidelines already issued as may be necessary from time to time.

b) Chairman, CENTAC shall be the final authority to settle disputes, if any, that may arise.

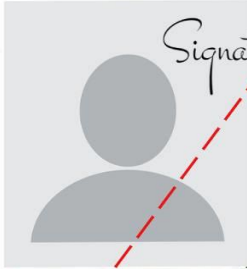

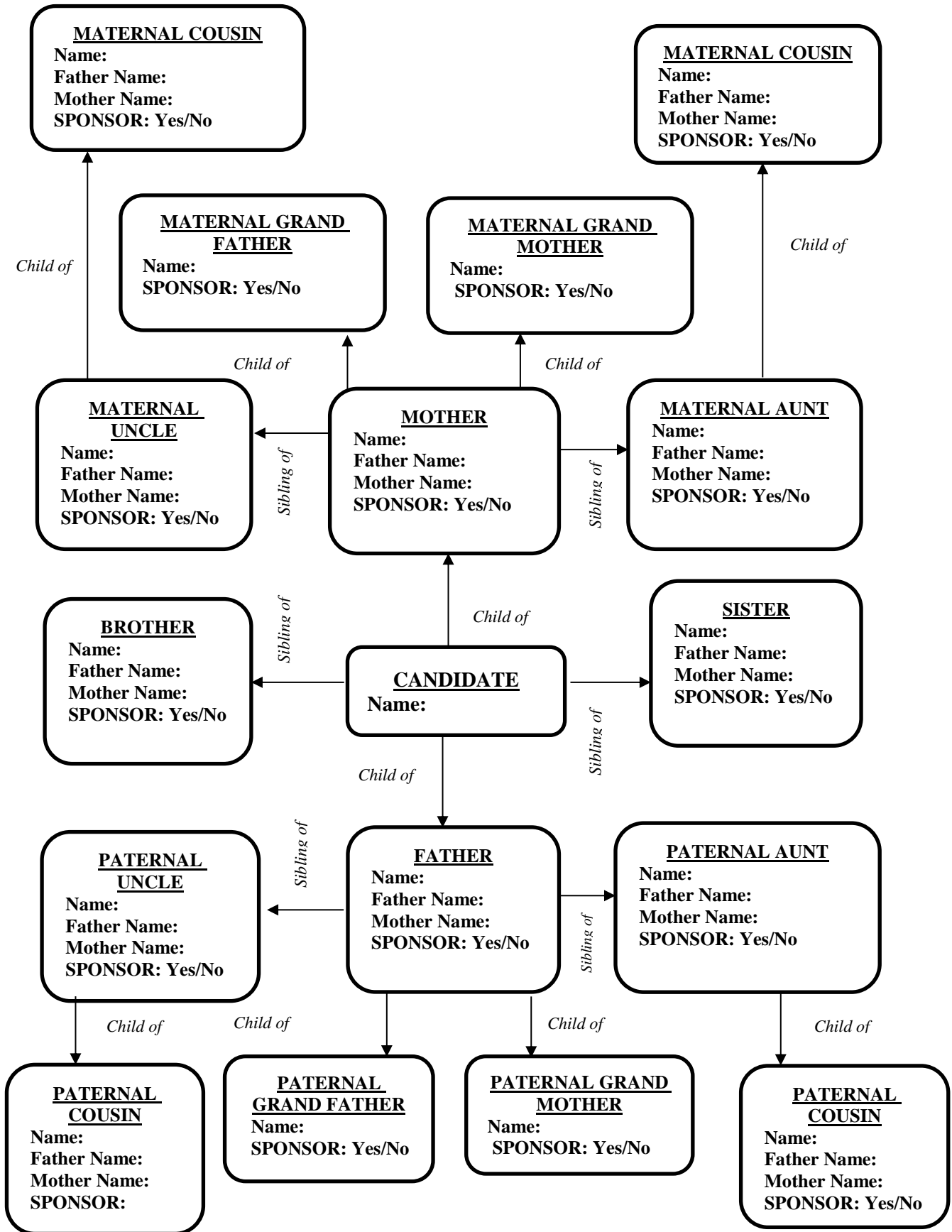
